GETTING STARTED:

- 1. First select an activity sheet to work on. (Fig.1)
- 2. Select the dough colours to work with.

USING TEXTURED ROLLERS:

- 1. Use the plain roller provided to flatten the dough on the white space outlined in the activity sheet. (Fig.2)
- 2. Choose a textured sleeve according to your activity sheet. (For example: Feather textured sleeve to be used for the bird activity sheet.) (Fig.3)
- 3. Now, take the chosen textured sleeve and slide it into the plain roller, to use it as a textured rolling pin. (Fig.4)

- 4. Now, roll the textured roller on your flatten dough to imprint the texture. (Fig.5)
- 5. Use the scraper / crinkler to cut out the excess dough if any, that has gone outside the given outlines on the white space. (Fig.6)

USING THE STAMP TOOL:

- 1. Choose a texture according to your activity sheet. (For example: Turtle textured sleeve for the ocean activity sheet.)
- 2. Attach the textured hemispherical sleeve on to the stamp tool. (Fig.7)
- 3. Use the plain roller provided to flatten the dough on the white space outlined in the activity sheet. (Fig. 2)
- 4. Stamp the textures on the flattened dough. (Fig.8)
- 5. Use the scraper / crinkler to cut out the excess dough if any that has gone outside the given outlines. (Fig.9)
