







# **OBJECT**

Be first to move all 10 of your marbles into the star point at the opposite end of the gameboard.

### **CONTENTS**

- 1 gameboard
- 60 Marbles (10 each of 6 colours)


## **GAME SET UP**

- 1. Carefully remove the circles from the gameboard holes.
- 2. Choose your star point. Each player does the same. In a 2-player or 4-player game, players take opposite points. In a 3-player game, players take every other star point.
- 3. Take 10 marbles of the same colour and place them in the holes of your star point. All players do the same.

### **GAME PLAY**

- 1. On your turn, move one of your marbles, according to the rules below. After you move, your turn is over play then continues to your left.
- Move one marble only. You may move in any direction, as long as your marble follows a black line.
- You may move to any adjacent empty hole (as shown in figure 1); or you may make one or more jumps. You cannot do both on your same turn. Rule 2 explains jumps.
- 2. JUMPS: Follow the rules below when you jump over another marble.
- You may jump over your own marble or over an opponent's marble

- Never remove a marble from the gameboard after jumping it.
- Jump over one adjacent marble only, along a straight line, to land in an empty hole adjacent to it. You may jump in any direction, as long as you follow a straight line – never change direction in the middle of the jump.
- You may make several consecutive jumps on your turn, as long as you jump one marble at a time to land in an empty hole adjacent to it.





FIGURE 3: Illegal Jumps

- See Figure 2 for legal jumps and Figure 3 for illegal jumps.

FIGURE 2: Legal Jumps

## **HOW TO WIN**

Be first to move each of your 10 marbles into each of the 10 holes of the opposite star point and you win the game!

### **GAME VARIATION**

If you wish to play several games, try this method of scoring. The winner of each game receives 10 points; other players receive 1 point for each marble in their opposite star points when the game ends. At the end of the last game, the player with the highest point total wins!
