NOTE:

Before starting the painting activity, keep handy the following items: (not provided with the kit) a toothpick, bowl of water, old newspapers and a waste cloth. Please cover the work surface area with sheets of old newspaper.


BEGIN GLASS PAINTING:

- Choose any one of the 2 printed acrylic sheets and peel off the sticker pasted on the back side of the acrylic sheet.
- Place the chosen acrylic sheet in the centre with a bowl of water, paint brush, the 3 paint bottles, palette and old waste cloth next to it.
- Each design consists of multiple areas within the design. You may choose to paint each area in a different colour. Plan out what colours you would like to paint where, in advance (See Colour Tips).

- Ensure that the side of the acrylic sheet where the design projections are present faces upwards.
- · Pour your chosen paint colors into the palette grooves, being careful not to over-squeeze and spill.
- Use a small piece of waste cloth to wipe the brush when changing colours.
- · Let all the brush strokes while painting be smooth, long and towards one direction at all times.
- If any bubbles are formed on the acrylic sheet while painting, prick the bubble with a tooth pick to burst the bubble and even out the surface.
- Once the acrylic sheet has been fully painted, keep it aside to dry completely.
- Always remember to close paint bottle caps when not in use to prevent drying.

AFTER PAINTING:

- Make sure that the acrylic sheet is completely dry.
- Place the reflection film sheet in-between the painted acrylic sheet and back-up board.
- · Align the edges.
- Holding the 3 components together, slowly slide the frame strips onto them (top & sides) to hold all the 3 components together tightly.
- Ensure that the corners of the strips are in alignment with each other.
- Carefully place the entire assembly onto the frame stand by sliding the bottom edge of the sheets inside the slot of the stand provided (Fig.1).
