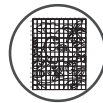

Note:

- Read through the instructions completely before beginning with the painting activity.
- Before starting the activity, keep handy the following items: A bowl of water, waste cloth, and old newspapers.
- Close the lids of the paint tubs when not in use.
- Use the waste cloth to wipe the brush in between colour change.
- Let all the paint strokes be smooth, long and in one direction for a neat finish.
- Cover your working surface with old newspapers. Place the Canvas Board in the centre with the paints, brush, paint palette, bowl of water and waste cloth next to it.

THE GRID METHOD

- This technique is used to transfer a small picture to a larger canvas for painting.
- Select 1 out of the 4 design options provided.
- Use the pencil and begin sketching one square at a time using the grid lines on the design sheet as reference (Fig.1).
- Your task is to transfer the design on the sheet on to the canvas block by block. Start at the top left corner and work your way across and down.
- Ensure that you are paying attention to only one block at a time to prevent confusion.
- Try and copy exactly what you see in the little square on the design sheet onto the corresponding square on canvas.
- Focus on getting the placement right for every line.
- Place the canvas board and the design sheet close together to make the copying process easier. If required, place the design sheet on top of the canvas board covering the other extra squares to focus better.
- Draw in light strokes so that you can erase any mistakes as you keep drawing.
- You can smoothen out the lines as you progress drawing.
- For curves, find where the curves meet on the grid line, then connect the dots.
- Continue copying the design one square at a time till the entire image is completely transferred onto the canvas.
- Now, the canvas is ready for painting.

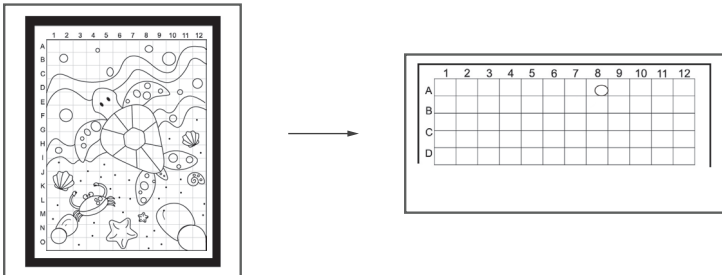

TIPS FOR CANVAS PAINTING:

The Canvas Art - Glitter Kit includes two glitter paints that will give your artwork a sparkling, glittery finish. Use the paints at appropriate spaces to make it look ravishing.

- Before you start painting, choose which colours you would like to paint where.
- To make your colours painted on the canvas darker or brighter; apply a second coat of paint on top of the first layer.
- If you would like to get a lighter shade of the colour, mix a drop or two of water to dilute the colour before painting (ensure water is not added in excess as watery paint may not apply well on canvas).
- You can also mix 2 paints together to get a new colour:

- Black + White = Grey
- White + Red = Pink
- Red + Blue + Yellow = Brown
- Red + Yellow = Orange
- Blue + Red = Purple

FRAMING & ASSEMBLING THE CANVAS

- Once the paints are completely dry, you can start making your frame.
- Detach the 4 cardboard frame pieces from the runner frame.
- Apply glue on both the ends and the centre of each cardboard frame piece and stick it onto the painted canvas (Fig.2)

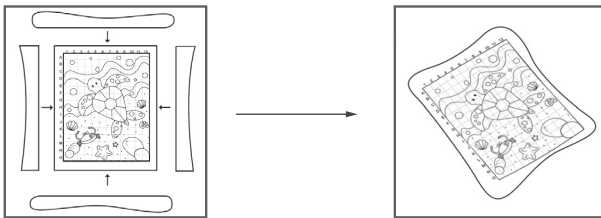

- To make your stand, detach the cardboard stand from the build-up within which the contents of the kit was placed (Fig.3).

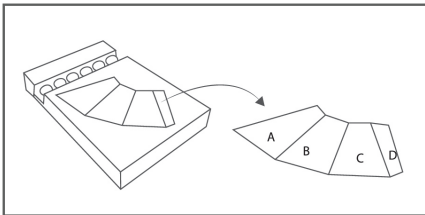

- This stand will help you place the framed painting on a table.
- All markings on the instruction sheet are only for indicative purposes and will not be found on the cardboard frame.
- Follow steps 1 – 4 in (Fig.4) to assemble your stand.

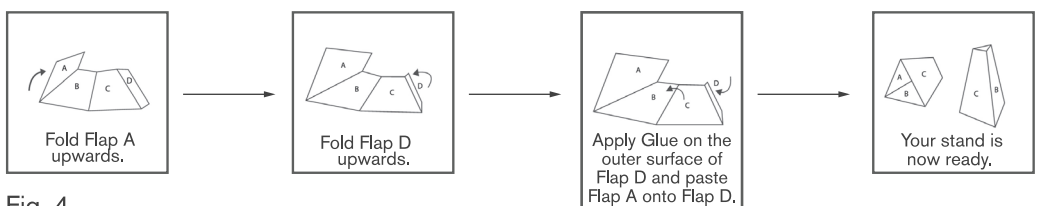

- Apply glue to one side of the assembled stand and paste it onto the back of your framed canvas board (Fig.5).

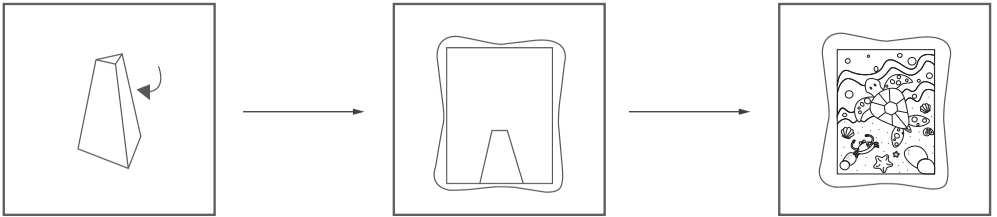
