With this Soap Making Kit, you can make your own colourful & fragrant soaps in 6 different unicorn-themed shapes!

Note:

- Please read the instructions completely before beginning the soap making activity.
- Before starting the activity, cover your work surface area with a sheet of waste newspaper (not provided with the kit).
- You will also need the following items to make your soaps which are not provided in the kit: A gas burner/ microwave oven, a microwave safe dish/ 2 saucepans and a waste cloth.
- Adult assistance and supervision is required.

MELTING THE SOAP BASE:

(NEEDS TO BE PERFORMED BY AN ADULT/ ADULT SUPERVISION REQUIRED)

- Cut approximately 50-60g of soap base from the soap base bar provided and chop it into small cubes for easy melting.
- While melting your soap cubes, ensure that it does not over heat or burn.
- You can melt the soap cubes using a gas burner or a microwave oven.

Melting with a gas burner:

- You will need a domestic gas burner and 2 steel or aluminum sauce pans of different sizes (not provided).
- Fill the big saucepan with water and fill the small saucepan with the soap cubes.
- Place the big saucepan with water on the gas burner and place the small saucepan with soap base on top such that it sits comfortably above of the big saucepan (Fig.1).

Caution: Never leave melting soap unattended.

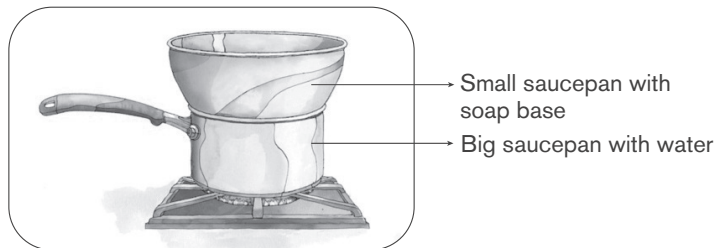

- Bring your water to a boil (once it has reached a boiling stage, lower the flame on your burner) and your soap will start to melt. Once your soap has completely melted take it off the gas. The process of melting the soap may take 5-10 minutes approx.

Melting with a microwave oven:

- Place the soap cubes in a microwave safe dish and heat it for 10 seconds in a microwave oven at high heat.
- If the soap base has not melted, repeat this step till the soap base has completely melted.

PREPARING THE SOAP FOR POURING:

- Mix the melted soap gently using the ice cream stick provided like a spatula.
- Ensure the soap cubes are all melted and smooth.
- There are 4 colours of soap colouring dye provided. Choose the required colour and add 1-2 drops into the melted soap base. You can add less or more of the colouring dye depending on how light or dark you want your soap colour to be.
- Add 1-2 drops of the fragrance into the melted soap base.
- Mix the contents together gently ensuring that the mixture does not foam or froth.

SOAP MOULDING:

- Once the soap base is mixed well and is smooth, pour the soap base into the chosen shape on the VAC form mould (Fig.2).

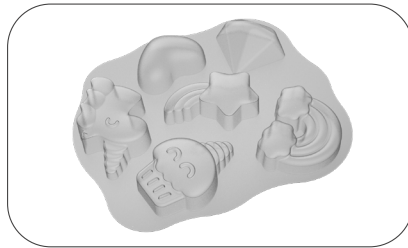

- Allow the soap to cool and set completely.
- This may take up to 1-2 hours. Leave over-night if possible.
- Once the soap has completely set. Slowly and gently bend/twist the VAC form mould to release the soaps from the VAC form mould (Fig.3).

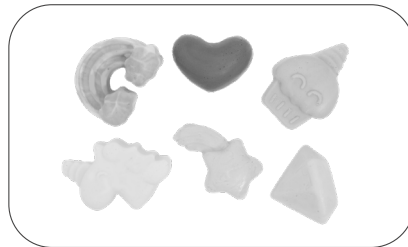

- If you are having trouble releasing the soap from the mould, you can dip the outer part of the VAC form in warm water (ensure the water does not touch the soap inside the VAC form mould) for a few seconds and try releasing the soap again.

MAKING DIFFERENT TYPES OF SOAPS!

- Hidden toy soap:

During the soap moulding step: pour a thin layer of soap base mixture into the VAC form mould shape, place the toy you would like to hide into the soap base and cover it up by pouring the rest of the soap base into the VAC form.

While using the soap, as the soap melts, you will be able to find the toy hidden inside.

- Multi-coloured soap:

For making this type of soap, you will need to make soap base mixtures in 2-3 colours. Pour a thin layer of mixture (1st colour) into the VAC form and let it set. Pour the next colour mixture into the VAC form mould forming another layer on top. You can repeat this process for every colour layer you want to add to your soap (Fig.4).

GIFT WRAPPING YOUR SOAPS:

- Place your soap on a gift wrapping sheet and fold the sheet as shown in steps from Fig. 5 to Fig. 9 and tie it up using a short piece of the ribbon (approximately 30cm) (See Fig. 10 to Fig.11) **NOTE:** You can cut the ribbon using scissors (not provided with the kit).

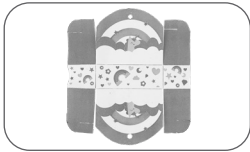

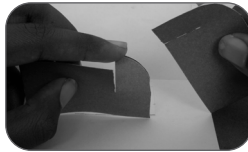

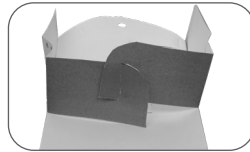

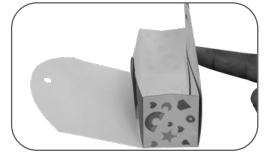

NOTE: The soaps contain glycerin which absorbs moisture. Hence when the soaps are left in the open they tend to form a film of moisture on top.
