Now let's get crafty by starting your DIY adventure!

Set Up :

Step 1: Choose Your Creation: Decide whether you want to make a stylish bracelet or a beautiful rakhi. Pick one wooden dial shape, a sticker and your acrylic paint pens to start decorating!

Step 2: Decorate Your Wooden Dial Piece: Place the wooden dial cutout on a flat surface. Place the sticker on the wooden dial piece. Add your own touch with the acrylic paint pens! (See Fig - 1)

Step 3: Preview Your Creation: Use the small cavity in your bead tray (Fig - 2) to lay out different bead combinations. Mix and match bead combinations until you love what you see!

Step 4: Thread It Together: Use elastic thread or rainbow thread and insert the thread through one hole of the wooden dial piece (top to bottom) (See Fig - 3a), then pull it through the second hole (bottom to top) (See Fig - 3b). Center the wooden dial piece on the thread.

Step 5: Add Beads: On both sides of the wooden dial cutout, add beads. To keep a bead in place, tie a small knot right after adding it. (See Fig - 4)

Step 6: Secure Your Masterpiece Don't lift it just yet! Tie 2-3 tight knots at both ends to lock the beads in place. Still slipping? Add one or two more knots for extra security.



Tip: Don't let your beads bounce away, seal the magic with strong, steady knots!

And... Tadaaa! You Did It!

Keep the fun going—make more rakhis and bracelets for your friends and family. Then, go ahead and tie them around their wrists to show your love and flaunt your creative flair!

Let your imagination sparkle—every knot tells a story, and every bead holds love.
